

Rail Manufacturing Facility

- New Manufacturing Facility located in Torbanlea, Fraser Coast
- Suitable for a range of major manufacturing and assembly works for the Fleet



Rollingstock (Fleet)

- 65 x 6 car trains
- Compatible with safety and accessibility standards
- Tunnel capable (Fire, Gradient, PSD)
 Options
- 15 x 6 car trains



Simulators & Mock Ups

- Fixed simulators to support the new fleet training for Train Crew
- Cab and saloon mock ups, inc Toilet



Rail Maintenance Facility

- Dedicated new Rail Maintenance
 Facility, located in the Gold Coast region
- 15years base, potential extensions of up to 4 x 5years
- Full fleet maintenance; preventative, corrective, overhauls and cleaning



Train Wash Facility

 Located near the new Maintenance Facility and Stabling Yard



Rail Stabling Yard Facility

- Located adjacent to the new Maintenance Facility
- 20 x 6 car train capacity
- Includes Train Crew facilities

• QTMP will create includes fitters, welders, sheet metal workers, electrical fitters, coach builders, programmers and technicians. During the construction phase this will also include carpentry, concreting and plumbing.
